Cultural identification is typically treated as a demographic category. By extension, the internal working model of racial identity is a clinical blind spot.

In his book, Emotionally Focused Therapy With African American Couples, Dr. Guillory suggests that therapists work most effectively with Black couples when they have a conceptual model for race-matters.

This workshop addresses useful clinical concepts (e.g., Black negative priming, racial distress cues, racial identity as a dynamic process) and how they can be integrated into emotionally focused therapy (EFT). Case studies and video clips of EFT intervention illustrate the work.
